Guidance for Parent – Online Learning

In line with the Scottish Government announcement regarding school arrangements for January, your child will commence online learning from Monday 11th January 2021. Face to face schooling will not recommence until at least the 1st February 2021. Following guidance from the Local Authority and Scottish Government your child's class teacher will provide Online Learning experiences during this period. Please find attached Plan and Guidance Notes.

Online Learning will commence on **MONDAY 11th JANUARY** and will be delivered on Microsoft Teams via Glow.

All pupils have a username and password to access this. Learning will consist of:

- Contact with the class teacher twice a day, split am and pm.
- One **daily** face to face teaching session with a Literacy or Numeracy focus in the morning, in which a follow up activity will be set.
- One **daily** check-in session in the afternoon to allow **pupils** to ask questions and talk about the activity they've been set.
- Completed work to be submitted by 3pm each Thursday
- Feedback from your child's class teacher will be provided after work is submitted.
- A 'Digital Classroom' learning grid will also be available on the Teams page, offering additional learning activities for pupils to engage with throughout this period. The Learning Grid will consist mainly of appropriate activities to consolidate prior learning. This will include Sumdog, IXL and weekly spelling words.
- Please see attached sheet for details of times and class organisation.
- If your child doesn't participate in either of the daily sessions, they will be marked absent for that session. Please let us know by either phone call or e-mail if your child is unwell or unable to take part.

The requirement to learn remotely will undoubtedly bring new challenges to your family and the teacher at this time. The provision of Online Learning is designed to support you and your child, however, we recognise engagement will vary from family to family due to existing and ongoing commitments. We thank you once again for your support and look forward to welcoming your child back to school when guidance allows.
